







## PRIME TIME AGUA BOA AMAZON 2010 HOSTED TRIP

Each of the last two years, we've reserved the last week of January at the Agua Boa Amazon Lodge's upriver houseboat on the Agua Boa River in the Amazon. Each of those trips resulted in truly outstanding fly rod fishing for trophy Peacock Bass.

There are many Peacock Bass operations in the Amazon, but only one that is strictly fly fishing and catch and release in a protected, clear water watershed, the Agua Boa River. For the fly fisher, this is the "cats meow" of Amazon operations.

Doug is a multi faceted fly fisherman who's talents range from being arguably the top striped bass guide on the Delta in northern California to owning both an environmental engineering firm and the Fish First fly shops in the Bay Area and Chico. Most important, he is a knowledgeable and well traveled fly fisherman who is fun to fish with.

## **Trip information:**

Dates and Logistics: Trip dates are January 23 – 30, 2010. You will depart from Manaus via 90 minute charter flight over the Amazon jungle early morning on January 23 – must be in Manaus on the  $22^{nd}$ . Manaus is approximately a 4 ½ hour flight from Miami or Atlanta. On the return, you can be in Miami by early evening on the  $30^{st}$ .

Price: \$4,600 which includes the charter flight and week at the lodge. Does not include other flights or overnights enroute.
